




The Collection

Over the years The Moseley Local History Society has accumulated a considerable collection of historical material which is currently stored in the Moseley Exchange. The collection includes documents, photographs, prints, books, magazines, papers, minutes, postcards, maps and various other objects. These have links to local places, organisations, people, schools and churches for example.

We plan to reorganise the collection in an accessible form and make it available to all. To this end the material needs to be copied and digitised so as to be stored in electronic form. It will then be made available via the internet, on disc or through other media. Internet access will be through the Moseley Society website.

The Project



1. Re-organisation and classification of the collection.
2. Enhanced storage of the original material in cabinets, cupboards, boxes and conservation document wallets.
3. Digitisation of all material for storage in electronic form.
4. Making the collection available to all via the internet and various other media.
5. Giving access to the collection for any interested person(s) or groups – the general public, schools, researchers etc.
6. Organisation of presentations, displays and lectures.
7. Provision of material for publication.
8. Providing opportunities for volunteers to develop skills in information technology, archival research, in presentation and conservation of material etc.
9. Employment of part time professional local historian and an IT technician.
